- The adornment cannot protrude more than 2 inches from the graduate's regalia.
- It must be uniform for all graduates in your organization (not custom for each).
- The color gold may not be used in the design or materials unless it is a previously established color for your organization. Gold is traditionally reserved for honors.
- The requested information below must be submitted and approved prior to ordering or distributing adornments to graduates.
